Straight-forward in style, the Leaping Horse 2014 Merlot has violet and dark fruit aromas with pleasant plum, black cherry and a little green olive character creeping into the flavor. Mouth filling yet smooth, Leaping Horse has created an unpretentious wine that can pair with just about anything.
